Event Document for *Duelist Alliance (DUEA)* Sneak Peek

Dear Tournament Organiser,

Thank you for running a Sneak Peek for the latest Yu-Gi-Oh! Trading Card Game set, *Duelist Alliance*! This document should help you in running the Sneak Peek according to the official rules and regulations. Please read those instructions carefully.

Date

The official Sneak Peek dates are **August 9th and 10th**. Sneak Peek events must not be run at a different date.

You are not allowed to open or forward any booster packs early, and/or post "spoilers" online.

Failing to comply with these restrictions may cause you to lose the privilege of running future official Yu-Gi-Oh! Trading Card Game events.

Materials

To run your Sneak Peek, you will receive a number of Sneak Peek kits. Each kit contains materials sufficient for 8 participants: 1 Game Mat, 8 promotional cards, and 40 boosters. You will also receive a Deck List form to print if needed.

Event Structure

As per recent events, in addition to casual, non-tournament events offering "Open Dueling" you may now run a competitive "Swiss Style" tournament at the same time.

If you choose to run a competitive "Swiss Style" event in addition to open Dueling, this event must be pre-sanctioned in COSSY using the "Sealed - rating" Tournament Style and "Local" Event Type, run using KTS and uploaded after the event.

The Details of a Sneak Peek:

- Players get 5 *Duelist Alliance* boosters to build a 20-card deck.
- A participation fee equal to the retail price of five boosters is suggested (20,- € or equivalent in local currency).
- **Unused Sneak Peek boosters may be sold at regular price, but only after the official release date. You must not sell kits or the promo cards or Game Mats and no player should be able to purchase more than five boosters at a Sneak Peek location.** If you choose to run a competitive "Swiss Style" tournament alongside "Open Dueling" then you may choose to award unused Sneak Peek boosters as prizes for that tournament.
- Each event gets a Yu-Gi-Oh! branded benefit: 1 Game Mat per 8 estimated players. If you run only "Open Dueling" then one Game Mat must be randomly awarded for each eight players or part thereof who has participated. If you choose to run a competitive "Swiss Style" tournament in addition to "Open Dueling", you may award up to 50% of the Game Mats as prizes for the tournament, and the remaining Game Mats must be awarded randomly. In either case, you must award 1 Game Mat for each 8 players or part thereof who attends your Sneak Peek.
- Each player gets a DUEA Sneak Peek promo card as participation prize. The card is allowed to be played in the Sneak Peek if handed out together with the boosters. Unused cards must be returned or destroyed and may not be used for any other purpose.
- Konami does not sponsor additional booster prizes for Sneak Peek events, or any support items for judge or staff. However, you can add additional prizes to the event at your discretion.

Deck Lists

You can choose to have players fill out Deck Lists as precaution against cheating. This, however, is not mandatory.

Reporting the Event

Tournaments should be uploaded to COSSY after the event and the number of participants in open dueling and in any tournament you have run should be reported to your local Organised Play distributor!
